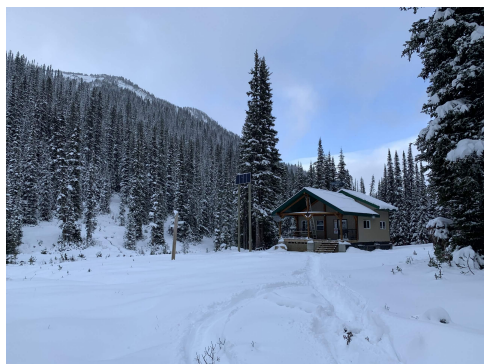


ALMOST! BUT NOT QUITE...

Our local mill is harvesting at Quartz this fall. We'll be staging our parking at the 9 km until early December and then will be parking back in the main lots while they finish off their harvest lower down. A few parking lots have been built just slightly up the East Quartz road, **LEFT of the Y**. Just a reminder to take care when travelling around the mine sites. The miners have put up flagging tape to mark hazards and mining areas, but be cautious especially during the early season!
