The forecast temps are telling us the warm and wet is over (for now). The cold will likely pull moisture from the snowpack in a good way and we might even get some sun this weekend.

There's still lots of early season hazards around so don't loose your brain and make dumb decisions that'll cost you an a-arm and a leg.
