On April 5, 2025 the Golden Snowmobile Club will once again host the Riley Suhan Backcountry Race, one of the best events in all of snowmobiling! This unique mountain race traverses a large loop of the Quartz Creek riding zone in Golden BC and is executed in a timed, relay format. For 2025, on top of the normal race that combines the times of a randomly chosen, 4 person team, we will have an additional pro-level race with a \$2500+ prize purse on a more challenging course. We're sorting out the details of this pro race but be assured that the idea is for it to be awesome for both spectators and participants alike. Entry to the second pro race will require placing in the top 30 of the main race. The pro race will have a more challenging lap that is slightly longer than the main race. We will announce more specifics as we iron them out.

We will have a new start/finish location in 2025 – Cabin Valley! Head left past the cabin and you'll be able to see the set-up. This will give better spectating for everybody at the start/finish area, including Dr. Poz who was really feeling left out in past years.



We've had approximately 10 cms this week of new and the temps have cooled slightly. The best snow is definitely in the high alpine right now and there's still some good snow to be had. Looks like there is snow on its way but the reports vary on how much to expect.

Staging Areas Latest Info

Quartz Creek

Conditions: Compacted main areas - some powder

Grooms scheduled: as needed

Fees: \$30/sled

Parking: main parking lot

Additional notes: Main area is compacted. Flat Trail in. Parking lot is cleared. East Quartz trail has been pushed.

Silent Pass

Conditions: packed powder Grooms scheduled: as needed

Fees: \$30/sled

Parking: 31km lot - please do not drive past. Road: Plowed on Feb 26! Much improved. Additional notes: Compaction in main areas.

Gorman Lake

Conditions: compacted - still some fresh

Grooms scheduled: As needed moving forward (once a week)

Fees: \$30/sled

Parking: 3.5km lower lot

Road: road is nicely gravelled. Call your kms! RR27

Additional notes:

Logging work on the first km of the trail in. Watch for vehicles.

Looks like come January, PWT will have a logging crew and hauling from the West Main road as well so will be maintaining the Dogtooth to the 3.5km lot most of the winter.
