

The freezing level will continue to work its way up in elevation but for the time being, there's still a ton of snow left to go shred.

# **Quartz Creek**

Conditions: spring snow Grooms scheduled: none

Fees: none

Parking: main parking lot

Additional notes: Main parking lot is dirt but snow starts right after kiosk. Still a snow ride into the cabin.

### **Silent Pass**

Conditions: spring snow

Grooms scheduled: done for the season

Fees: none

Parking: park wherever you can. trailers not recommended

Road: Road in is rough, lots of puddles and bumps.

Additional notes: Road is muddy and bumpy. trail is rotting but still almost all snow. turn arounds for trailers are limited.

#### **Gorman Lake**

Conditions: spring snow

Grooms scheduled: done for the season

Fees: none

Parking: park wherever you can. trailers not recommended

Road: Call your kms! RR27

Additional notes:

Gorman has very limited chances for trailers to turn around. 4×4 trucks can park at upper lot. Still lots of snow up there and it's possible to get stuck. Truck recovery gear is not the worst idea...
