## Staging Areas Latest Info

### Quartz Creek

**Conditions:** Excellent early season riding above 1800m

**Grooms scheduled:** Nov28

**Fees:** \$30

**Parking:** Check with staff the day of: Trucks with trailers - regular parking lot. Trucks with decks can venture to the 2km mark.

**Road:** road is icy. those pilon

**Additional notes:**

Quartz has had amazing riding this week. Parking for trucks with decks has been up to the 2km marking but sledding from the parking lot is totally possible; it's a bit thin but not the worst.

The trail in from 2km onwards is has a good amount of compacted snow. There are still open creek crossings in the Twin Chutes areas higher up in the trail. These may get filled in if we can get the groomer there.

## Silent Pass

**Conditions:** unreported but probably pretty good

**Grooms scheduled:** none

**Fees:** none

**Parking:** 46km

**Road:** muddy - call your kms. A lot of industry traffic. Yield to bigger vehicles.

**Additional notes:**

logging is happening past the 45km turn off to Silent Pass's upper parking lot this year. We've been told this will happen till at least late February. This means that sledders heading to Silent should be able to drive to the 46km parking lot for most of the winter.
